

My favorite song (15/04-19/04)

Choose a song (in English) that you love listening to these days. You have to accomplish different tasks with this song:

1. **Is it grammatically correct?** Take a look to the song's lyrics and find some grammatical mistakes, or slang words used in the song you chose, and correct them. Example: *fortunate son* (Creedence Clearwater Revival)

<i>It ain't me, it ain't me</i> <i>I ain't no millionaire son, no, no</i> <i>It ain't me, it ain't me</i> <i>I ain't no fortunate one, no</i>	<i>It isn't me, it isn't me</i> <i>I'm not a millionaire son, no, no</i> <i>It isn't me, it isn't me</i> <i>I am not a fortunate one, no</i>
" Ain't " is used instead of the negative form of the verb to be in the present simple, in this example It is used in informal spoken settings.	" Ain't no " is grammatically incorrect, because " ain't " is a negative contraction, so we can't use " no ", too (double negative is wrong in English)

2. **Is there any mispronounced-word?** Listen to the song while reading the lyrics, and mark the words that you think are mispronounced. Example:

❖ *But when the taxman **comes** to the door* → the singer doesn't pronounce the -s.

3. **Why do you like this song?** Write a paragraph explaining why you love listening to the song you chose. You have to write 50 words minimum

Remember to include:

- The names of both the song and the group or singer.
- The song's lyrics.
- The links to the resources used in the bibliography. Example:
